I am writing on behalf of the FY 2016 Economic Development Assistance Program, Investments for Public Works and Economic Development Facilities, CFDA Number: 11.300, grant application submitted by Lincoln County Port Authority.

Lincoln County Port Authority is requesting funds to construct a rail spur at its Kootenai Business Park, accessing the Burlington Northern Santa Fe (BNSF) main line.
