3 SECTION 1. SHORT TITLE.

4 This Act may be cited as the "Major Richard Star5 Act".

1	SEC. 2. ELIGIBILITY OF DISABILITY RETIREES WITH FEWER
2	THAN 20 YEARS OF SERVICE AND A COMBAT-
3	RELATED DISABILITY FOR CONCURRENT RE-

6	(a) Concurrent Receipt in Connection With
7	CSRC.—Section 1413a(b)(3)(B) of title 10, United States
8	Code, is amended by striking "creditable service," and all
9	that follows and inserting the following: "creditable serv-
10	ice—
11	"(i) the retired pay of the retiree is
12	not subject to reduction under sections
13	5304 and 5305 of title 38; and
14	"(ii) no monthly amount shall be paid
15	the retiree under subsection (a).".
16	(b) Concurrent Receipt Generally.—Section
17	1414(b)(2) of title 10, United States Code, is amended
18	by striking "Subsection (a)" and all that follows and in-
19	serting the following: "Subsection (a)—
20	"(A) applies to a member described in
21	paragraph (1) of that subsection who is retired
22	under chapter 61 of this title with less than 20
23	years of service otherwise creditable under
24	chapter 1405 of this title, or with less than 20
25	years of service computed under section 12732
26	of this title, at the time of the member's retire-

ment if the member has a combat-related dis-
ability (as that term is defined in section
1413a(e) of this title), except that in the appli-
cation of subsection (a) to such a member, any
reference in that subsection to a qualifying
service-connected disability shall be deemed to
be a reference to that combat-related disability;
but
"(B) does not apply to any member so re-
tired if the member does not have a combat-re-
lated disability.".
(c) Technical and Conforming Amendments.—
(1) Amendments reflecting end of con-
CURRENT RECEIPT PHASE-IN PERIOD.—Section
1414 of title 10, United States Code, is further
amended—
(A) in subsection $(a)(1)$ —
(i) by striking the second sentence;
and
(ii) by striking subparagraphs (A) and
(B);
(B) by striking subsection (c) and redesig-
nating subsections (d) and (e) as subsections
(c) and (d), respectively; and

2	striking paragraphs (3) and (4) .
3	(2) SECTION HEADING.—The heading of such
4	section 1414 is amended to read as follows:
5	"§1414. Members eligible for retired pay who are also

7	tion: concurrent receipt".
8	(3) TABLE OF SECTIONS.—The table of sections
9	at the beginning of chapter 71 of such title is

11	1414 and inserting the following new item:
	"1414. Members eligible for retired pay who are also eligible for veterans' dis- ability compensation: concurrent receipt.".
12	(4) CONFORMING AMENDMENT.—Section
13	1413a(f) of such title is amended by striking "Sub-
14	section (d)" and inserting "Subsection (c)".
15	(d) EFFECTIVE DATE.—The amendments made by
16	this section shall take effect on the first day of the first
17	month beginning after the date of the enactment of this
18	Act and shall apply to payments for months beginning on
19	or after that date.
