Dear Mr. President:

Thank you for your consistent commitment to the pro-life cause. The pro-life majority in the United States Senate stands with you in protecting the sanctity of every human life.

In just two years, your Administration has become one of the most pro-life Administrations in our nation's history. For example, we applaud your fight to ensure the conscience rights of healthcare professionals are protected, prevent taxpayer funding under Title X from going to facilities to perform or refer for abortion, and prevent taxpayer dollars from funding foreign abortion providers overseas through your Protecting Life in Global Health Assistance program.

As you know, Congress has many long-standing pro-life protections in both appropriations provisions and in authorizing legislation.
