I am writing on behalf of the Health Resources and Services Administration Network Development Planning Grant (CFDA No. 93.912) application submitted by St. Joseph Medical Center to support the Western Montana Rural Nursing Collaborative (WMRNC).

Montana's counties are considered Medically Underserved Populations or Areas, and providing high-quality, cost-effective healthcare to the citizens of these medically underserved counties requires a collaborative effort.
