Dear Senator Daines:

Thank you for your letter of November 14, 2017, on behalf of your constituents, the farmers and ranchers of Montana, who have been affected by the severe drought conditions in 2017. I apologize for the delayed response.

Recognizing that counties and Tribal reservations across much of Montana experienced record low levels of precipitation, high temperatures, and wildfires, which had substantial impacts on harvests and infrastructure for farmers and ranchers in the region, the Farm Service Agency (FSA) has provided Emergency Conservation Program (ECP) assistance within available funding limits. Should Congress make additional funding available for ECP, FSA will work with the affected counties to evaluate the conditions and needs at that time. ECP projects that have been initiated will be provided the opportunity to request a 6-month extension up to June 1, 2018.
